SEIZURE QUESTIONNAIRE

1. How old was your pet when the first witnessed seizure took place?
2. When did the most recent seizure take place?
3. Did the signs begin in only one part of the body?
4. Did your pet lose consciousness or seem confused?
5. Was your pet standing and walking, or was he/she lying on his/her side?
6. Has your pet displayed any other signs like lip licking, fly biting, aggression when not unconscious?
7. Did you notice any salivation, urination and/or defecation while seizing?
8. How often are the seizures occurring?
9. If your pet has cluster seizures:
 - How many seizures occur over one day?
 - How far apart are the seizures?
 - About how long do the seizures last?
 - How many days does a cluster episode go on for?
 - How long is the period between cluster episodes?
10. As well as you can, describe a typical seizure.

11. What did your pet do after the seizure?

12. Besides the seizures, has your pet displayed any atypical behavior? (circling, change in disposition, standing in corners, increased anxiety, etc)

13. What diagnostic tests have been performed in relation to this problem?

14. At this time, what medication(s), including dose is your pet taking for the seizures?

15. Is there any history of seizures in the bloodline?

16. What other medical problems does your pet have?

17. What are your goals in seeing the neurologist today?
